



Amateur Owner Rider Status

Complete this form if you wish to participate as an Amateur Owner Rider in the National Futurity. Please fax or post this completed form back to Head Office.

Your application for an Amateur Owner Rider Status must be true and correct in each detail.

The Rider, or direct family member (mother, father, daughter, son, sister, brother) of the rider, MUST be the current financial owner of the horse.

Amateur means, regardless of one's equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, a person is considered an amateur who meets the criteria below:

Not considered an Amateur if:

1. Has accepted remuneration directly or indirectly for breaking, riding, training and schooling, driver, halter preparation showing in halter or under saddle.
2. Has accepted remuneration for conducting Clinics or Seminars or given instruction in showing, training or riding.
3. Has given instruction at Clinics for remuneration on any discipline pertaining to ASHS.
4. Has performed any of the above list of activities for which another person in his/her family or corporation or partnership which a member of his/her family controls will remuneration directly or indirectly.
5. Has performed such activities while accepting remuneration directly or indirectly for employment in another capacity for an Employer or a member of the said Employer's family who owns, boards or trains the involved horse.
6. Has ridden or exhibited in halter at horse shows any horse he/she or a member of his/her family accepts remuneration directly or indirectly for boarding and training.
7. Has won a Championship under saddle at National, Royal or State level.

The following activities shall not affect the Amateur Owner Rider Status of a person who is otherwise qualified:

- a. The writing of books/articles pertaining to horses.
- b. Accepting remuneration for judging & stewarding.
- c. Receiving prizemoney.
- d. Having the occupation of farrier, veterinarian, thoroughbred trainer, trotting trainer.
- e. Owning or operating a saddlery, stud, breeding farm or boarding stables.

Rules Explanation:

The rule means that anyone who is employed by a training establishment to do duties other than riding, breaking, training, schooling, driving, showing or preparing halter horses is eligible to be an amateur. Spouses and immediate family of a trainer are also able to be an amateur as long as they are not involved with the breaking, training, schooling, riding or showing any of the horses the trainer is being paid to work with. People who board horses are eligible for amateur status as long as they do not ride, show, train or do any of the tasks in 1-6 of the rules for the boarders. If you are not being paid money for any of those tasks in 1-6 of the rules, but are exchanging goods or services for those tasks you would also be seen to be receiving remuneration indirectly.
