ABOUT THE MAIDEN CAMPDRAFT SERIES 13

- The series will run from 1st January 2009 to 31st December 2009.
- The series is open to any registered Australian Stock Horse, owned by a Financial Member of the Australian Stock Horse Society. To be eligible for qualification, the horse must be registered at time of qualification.
- All final's prizemoney will be paid to the registered owner of the horse.

QUALIFICATION

- The horse must be a Maiden horse on 1st January 2009 to be eligible to qualify for the State Maiden Series.
- To qualify for the State Maiden Series, the horse must place 1st – 10th or ribbon place in any Maiden, Novice, Open, Ladies or Stallion Campdraft.
- The completed qualification form must be returned to Head Office and must be verified by the local Committee, being signed by an authorised person (Secretary or President).

STATE FINALS - TOP END (Northern Territory and North Queensland)

- Management Councils wishing to host a State Final must notify Head Office of the date and venue.

- All horses qualifying for a State Final are eligible to compete in the National Final. Members wishing to take part in a State Final may compete in the State the horse qualified in or in the State they normally reside, but not both. That is, you can only compete in one State Final.
- The horse may be ridden by any rider at the Series Final. Once the rider has ridden the first round of the Series Final the same rider must ride in the second round and the final round. Should the rider be injured and unable to participate, the rider may be substituted.
- The horse with the highest aggregate score over the two rounds and the final will be the winner.
- The first ten placegetters in both rounds and the final will be eligible for prizemoney and trophies.
- No substitute horses will be allowed for the Maiden Series Final after the close of entries.

Nomination Fee: Eligible horses for which the \$22 qualification fee was paid may be entered in the State final for a \$40 nomination fee (total \$62) plus cattle levy.

Prizemoney: Will be based on the number of horses nominated in the State Final - \$1,500 (minimum 20 horses) or \$500 (5-20 horses). A minimum of 5 horses must be nominated for a State Final to proceed.
