National Pointscore System - RULES

This pointscore is to award performances in various categories that are accrued by horse - handler/rider combinations.

- 1. For performance points to be accepted, the following MUST apply:
 - Handler/Rider current financial member of ASHLA
 - Handler/Rider current financial member of ASHS
 - Horse owner (not necessarily owned by competitor)
 current financial member of ASH
 - Horse Registered ASH
- 2. Any performances entered must be accrued by the one horse/rider combination, or one horse/handler combination. ie it is possible to have one horse competed by more than one rider/handler however any rider/handler is treated as a separate combination and must have their own entries with their own Cover Sheet and Performance Sheets. Exception A member may have more than one horse in a Final or Championship. If during the judging of the Championship or Final, the horses are to be judged as a group, and not individually worked out where the handler/rider can swap horses, it is permissible to have a substitute handler/rider perform the member's other horse/s in the same Final or Championship, and still have performances gained be accepted. It is expected that ASHLA members will hold to the spirit of the Pointscore competition, and only use this exception when it was not possible for them to handle/ride their other entry/s due to how the event was being judged. Ring clashes, illness or injury are not exceptions.
- 3. To be eligible for High Point, all SECTIONS of the minimum of four that are counted, ie Led, Working, Campdraft etc must have the same horse rider/handler combination.
- 4. Entries to be limited to a maximum of **20** performances it is the ASHLA member's responsibility to decide which are their best performances, using the score system following.

All performances to be scored as follows:

- 1st 5 points
- 2nd 4 points
- 3rd 3 points
- 4th 2 points
- 5th 1 point and 1 point for each recognised place (where a ribbon has been awarded) thereafter

Champion 5 points Reserve 4 points Supreme 5 points If placing received at any Capital City Royal, National or State ASH Championships, an extra 5 points are added to the points gained for each placing, ie 3rd = 3 points plus extra 5 points = 8 points for 3rd placing

- All under saddle performances must be attained in classes open to all breeds, or those restricted to registered Australian Stock Horses. Led class points are only allocated to Australian Stock Horse classes.
- b) Rider classes, Horsemanship events, Progeny Owner groups, Teams/Pairs events are not accepted
- c) In the event of a horse attaining an equal or divided placing in an event, the points pertaining to the highest place will be awarded.
- d) Only performances attained in the period from 1 January to 31 December in each competition year will be accepted.
- e) There is no limit to the number of horses a member may enter in the competition, but each horse competed by the member will be pointed as a single combination and must have their own Cover Sheet and Performance Sheets.
- f) Junior Riders are eligible for the Junior Point Score, which will be scored on all events open to riders 13 years and under 18 years.
- g) Stallions are eligible to be ridden/handled in events by competitors 18 years and over.
- h) Any member submitting false points will face disqualification. Random checks may be made to competition organisers for confirmation of records.
- No points will be accepted for any competition held on the weekend of the ASHLA Annual General Meeting.
- j) All winners in the Pointscore Competition will be notified as soon as possible following the competition year. Presentations are currently held at the ASHLA AGM. Results will be published in the ASH Journal.

ASHLA (Australian Stock Horse and Lady Rider) Class

Competitors are allowed one mount in the ASHLA event – a member can pre enter an ASHLA class multiple times, however must choose which horse to compete on and scratch other entries prior to competition start.

No Horse or rider substitution is allowed in an ASHLA competition that is pre entered. eg. Horse and rider combination entered for ASHLA event at a Royal show cannot be changed just prior to the event. The nominated horse and rider combination at close of entry is the only combination that can compete.

Submitting Performance Sheets

I. Performance records are to be in the hands of the Pointscorer postmarked 31 January, the following year for points up to and including 31 December. Points for new members are valid from date of joining. Renewal of membership must be paid by 31 March in order for points to be valid from 1 January.

- II. The onus is on the member to ensure the Pointscorer has received their performances.
- III. Peformances will be rejected if the performances have been altered or are illegible.
- IV. The performances must be accompanied by a National Point Score Cover Sheet for each horse/handler/rider combination. All sections entered to be ticked. Each section entered must have its own performance sheet.
- V. There must be at least five nominations in a section for a Runner Up trophy to be awarded.

SENIOR HIGH POINT ALL ROUND COMPETITOR – To be eligible, must have entered a minimum of four sections.

JUNIOR HIGH POINT ALL ROUND COMPETITOR – To be eligible, must have entered a minimum of four sections - All points taken in any category including restricted age events are eligible for this award.

HIGH POINT OVERALL - Highest point score out of Senior and Junior High Point
