Please note: The horse must be ridden by a lady to be eligible for Ladies Rookie Horse and a man to be eligible for Mens Rookie Horse.

**Open Horse** - Ladies, Mens & Juniors - The horse must be ridden by a lady to be eligible for Ladies Open Horse, a man to be eligible for Mens Open Horse and a Junior to be eligible for Juniors Open Horse.
