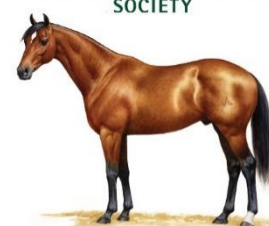

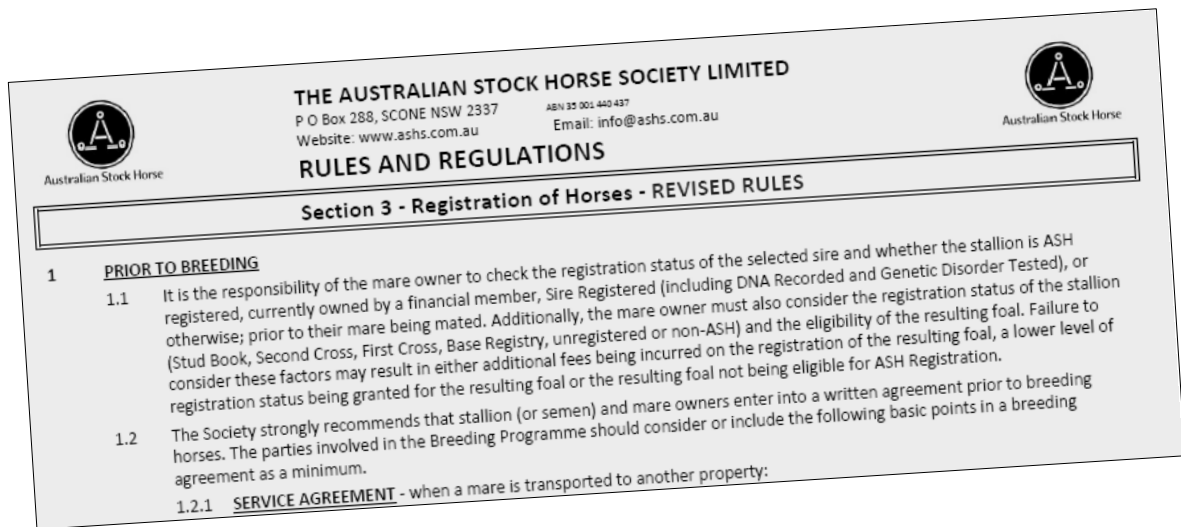

# RULES and REGULATIONS

## REVISED RULES – FIRST CROSS



Members are advised, revised Rules and Regulations for Registration of Horses have been adopted by the Board and some important changes are **effective from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024**. We take this opportunity for members to note some important changes (not limited to) as outlined below:

### FIRST CROSS REGISTRATION

From 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024, a DNA sample must be submitted to the Society for Mares and Fillies to be eligible for registration. A DNA profile will be compulsory, parentage testing (where possible) and Genetic Disorder Testing for HERDA will be compulsory components for registration. Any horse reported with a parentage anomaly will be REJECTED.

Registration fees for First Cross Mares and Fillies will increase from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024 to include the cost of DNA testing as follows: Fillies - under 4 years ..... **\$300**, Mares - 4 years & over ..... **\$360**  
NEW fees include: GST, DNA and Genetic Testing.

An ASH Breeding Certificate or acceptable proof of service remains compulsory. In cases where a sire and/or dam does not have DNA profile available to the Society, parentage may be accepted based on a signed ASH Breeding Certificate or other acceptable proof of service as defined under the rules.

First Cross Mares and Fillies will be Genetic Disorder Tested for HERDA and the following will apply:

- ❖ Horses testing negative will be accepted.
- ❖ Horses with a single copy of the disorder (carrier) will be accepted and the result noted on the registration.
- ❖ Horses with a double copy of the disorder (affected) will be REJECTED.

### NOTICE: ALL REGISTRATION TYPES


Compulsory DNA testing for natural service and Genetic Disorder Testing is under review through a consultative process. Members are advised, compulsory DNA testing and Genetic Disorder Testing may become a requirement at any time (for any registration or mating type) from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024.

# EMBRYO TRANSFERS

## DONOR MARES MUST HAVE A DNA PROFILE



**EMBRYO**

Sire & Dam should be DNA profiled prior to planning an Embryo Transfer program to enable eligible progeny to be eligible for registration.

**Utilising an EMBRYO TRANSFER breeding method?**

- Registered ASH Donor mares must have a DNA profile recorded with the Society.
- Require a DNA kit for a Registered ASH Donor mare, contact the Society on 02 6545 1122 with credit card.

**Wanting to REGISTER an Embryo Transfer foal?**

- Resulting progeny must be DNA tested and parentage verified, as required under the Rules.
- Submit the Application for Registration with ASH Breeding Certificate and payment of fees. A DNA kit will be forwarded to the owner for collection of a hair sample by the owner and an adult witness.

# ASH BREEDING CERTIFICATES

## HAVE YOU BRED A MARE THIS SEASON?

### ASH BREEDING CERTIFICATES

We remind Members that EVERY Application for Registration requires an ASH Breeding Certificate.

It is an agreement between the mare and stallion owner as to who purchases the Certificate. The stallion owner or authorised agent must complete and sign the Certificate for all matings.

The mare owner will retain the original Breeding Certificate for Registration of progeny, and the stallion owner will retain the copy.

# FIRST CROSS MARES and FILLIES

## DNA and GENETIC DISORDER TESTING FROM 1<sup>st</sup> JANUARY 2024

**One STUD BOOK Registered Australian Stock Horse parent.**  
If sire ASH Registered, must be Sire Registered.



The First Cross Registration fees for Mares and Fillies will change from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024, as a DNA profile and Genetic Disorder Testing for HERDA will be compulsory.

[Applications received by the Society after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024](#), will be required to pay the following registration fees:


<b>Fillies under 4 years .....</b>	<b>\$300</b>
<b>Mares 4 years &amp; over .....</b>	<b>\$360</b>

Complete your Application for Registration and attach an ASH Breeding Certificate signed by the Stallion Owner. The horse will need to be inspected by a Society Inspector, or video footage for inspection purposes be submitted to the Society. Then submit your application with payment of the required fees. Once your application has been verified by the Society as acceptable under the rules, a DNA kit with instructions for the owner to collect a hair sample with an adult witness will be issued by the Society.

Please be aware, the additional procedural steps for DNA, will increase the overall processing time from submitting the application to completing the application. **[Submit your applications early, to avoid disappointment.](#)**

**Nutrien Classic Campdraft** - Highest Placed Australian Stock Horse: \$1,000 prizemoney\* and cotton combo rug.

**Nutrien Performance Horse Challenge** - Highest Placed Australian Stock Horse: \$500 prizemoney\*.

**Nutrien Classic Campdraft** - Highest Placed Heritage Stock Horses: 1<sup>st</sup> - \$5,000\*, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$3,000\* and 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$2,000\*.

Eligibility Conditions\* for Registered Australian Stock Horse awards are as follows:

- ❖ Horse must be a Registered Australian Stock Horse and Registered Owner must be a Financial Member of the Australian Stock Horse Society for 2024.
- ❖ Horses must compete in the Nutrien Equine Classic Campdraft or Challenge, in accordance with the Nutrien Equine Classic Rules.
- ❖ Horses must place in the Top 10 of the Nutrien Equine Classic Campdraft – Final, OR the Nutrien Performance Horse Challenge – Overall to be eligible for Australian Stock Horse Society sponsored awards.
- ❖ HSH AWARDS (in addition to the above) - Horses must be recognised as a Heritage Stock Horse on the ASHS Online Stud Book and the horse must have been PURCHASED at the 2021 or 2022 Nutrien Classic Sale, when the HSH incentives were offered by the ASHS.

Prizemoney will be paid by ASHS to the Registered Owner of the horse at time of competition, within 30 days of the event, based on eligibility and results provided by Nutrien Ag Solutions.

# HORSE BRANDING FOR REGISTRATION

## SOME HELPFUL TIPS



### SELECTING THE CORRECT FOALING SEASON YEAR BRAND

In the [SOUTHERN HEMISPHERE](#) (Australia, New Zealand, etc) the Foaling Season Year Brand (bottom number) relates to a twelve-month period from 1<sup>st</sup> August to 31<sup>st</sup> July, not the calendar year.

If you have three foals born 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022, 7<sup>th</sup> February 2023 and 29<sup>th</sup> May 2023, they are ALL born in the **2022 Foaling Season** (1<sup>st</sup> August 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2023). As a result, they ALL need to be branded with the Foaling Season Year Brand - number “2” (the bottom number).

In the [NORTHERN HEMISPHERE](#) (United States of America, United Kingdom, etc), the Foaling Season Year Brand (bottom number) relates to the calendar year the foal is born.

#### What to do if you have branded the horse with the incorrect Foaling Season Year Brand?

Providing there is sufficient space beneath the existing brand, brand the correct number underneath the existing number brands. Do not brand beside the existing brand, as the bottom number must always reflect the Foaling Season the horse was born. If insufficient space beneath the existing brand, the horse may be branded beneath another brand or on another body part (ie, near thigh, off shoulder, etc).

### STOCK BRANDS

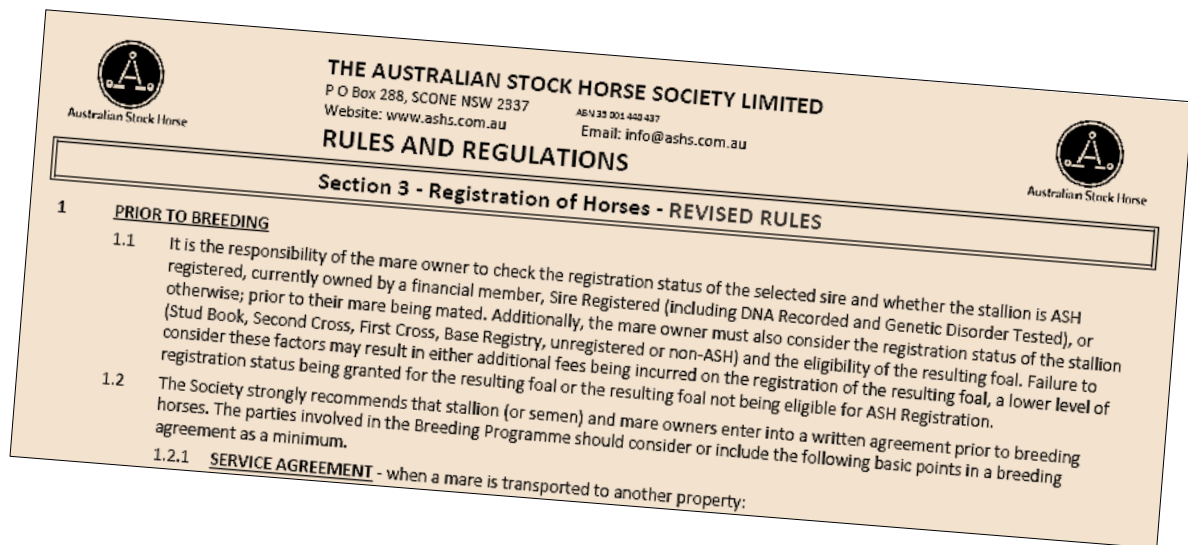
Registration of a stock brand with a Department of Agriculture may be compulsory in your state. Please contact the relevant state/territory authority to confirm the registration requirements before branding. In some states, the branding authority may issue penalties for using an unregistered brand.

It is the responsibility of the owner to abide by state government requirements in relation to livestock identification. When brand registration for livestock is not compulsory in your state, a personalised brand may be used.

*The Society will accept freeze or fire brands. Microchips do NOT waive the ASHS requirement of having a horse branded for registration purposes. Whilst the Department of Agriculture in your state may not require horses to be branded, branding is compulsory for ASHS registration and identification purposes.*

## PARENT IDENTIFIED WITH A GENETIC DISORDER



Members are advised, revised Rules and Regulations for Registration of Horses have been adopted by the Board and some important changes are **effective from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024**. We take this opportunity for members to note some important changes (not limited to) as outlined below:

### Horses with a parent identified on Society records with a Genetic Disorder

#### NEW Applications for Registration submitted after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024

In regards to Applications for Registration submitted after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024, any horse (except geldings) with a parent identified on Society records as positive for OLWS, HERDA, HYPP, PSSM1, MH or GBED, must be DNA profiled and Genetic Disorder Tested (for the positive disorder) prior to registration being accepted by the Society. In regards to the result, the following applies:

- ❖ Horses tested negative (n/n) will be accepted.
- ❖ Horses with a single copy of OLWS (n/O), HERDA (n/Hr), PSSM1 (n/P1), MH (n/Mh) or GBED (n/Gb) will be accepted.
- ❖ Horses with a double copy of PSSM1 (P1/P1) or MH (Mh/Mh) will be accepted.
- ❖ Horses with a double copy of OLWS (O/O), HERDA (Hr/Hr), HYPP (H/H) or GBED (Gb/Gb) or single copy of HYPP (n/H) will be REJECTED.
- ❖ Genetic Disorder results will be noted on the horse's registration, if accepted.

**Fees** - In addition to the registration fee, the following fees will apply for Stud Book and Second Cross horses with a parent identified on Society records with a Genetic Disorder. First Cross and Base Registry fees, automatically include the cost for these tests from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024.

- Mares and Fillies: **\$95** DNA test and **\$45** HERDA test fees will apply.
- Stallions and Colts: **\$95** DNA test and **\$130** 6GDT test fees will apply.
- Geldings: **Testing not required**, unless the gelding has sired progeny.
