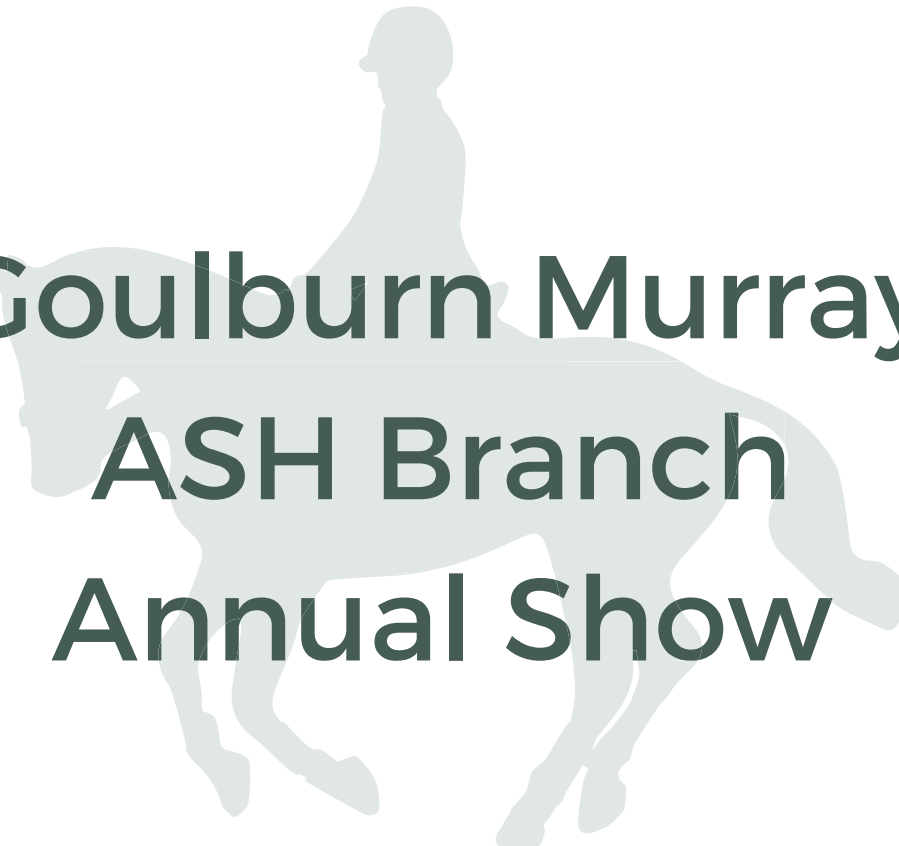

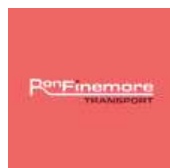
AWEC Stabling and Camping to be booked via the AWEC Nominate Portal (see over for more detail).

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 The Goulburn Murray Branch of the Australian Stock Horse Society Limited Annual Show is conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Australian Stock Horse Society Limited. Swabbing may take place
2. It is a condition on entry that competitors, handlers and spectators, whether actually engaged in an event or not, do so at their own risk, and will indemnify and save harmless The Australian Stock Horse Society, Goulburn Murray Branch and its Committee, Members, Servants and Sponsors from all claims, suits or demands arising out of an injury, personal or otherwise caused by or arising out of their presence.
3. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, add or amend both classes and prizes at any time. Equally the Committee reserves the right to refuse admittance to any person as they deem necessary.
4. All entries must be financial members of the Australian Stock Horse Society. Proof of registration and current membership (including ASHLA) must be produced if requested.
5. The Judge's decision will be final. Any protest must be lodged in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes after the event and be accompanied by a fee of \$100.00 which is refundable if the protest is upheld. In accordance with national policy all disputes will then be referred to ASHS for resolution.
6. Youth competitors: Age is taken as at 28 November 2025, youth under 13 years can enter unregistered horses in Youth handler and ridden classes. Youth competitors must wear an ASA approved hard hat. Under no circumstances can Youth handle or ride Stallions or Colts.
7. All classes to be ridden in snaffle bits (excluding English Attire).
8. Classes will not be held waiting for late competitors.
9. Competitors to provide their own Number Holders.
10. In Led classes, entires (2 years and over) must be under the control of a bit in their mouth.
11. All stallions must be doubled tied and/or hobbled when not performing.
12. Late entries will incur a double entry fee.
13. Hi-Point Competitions
 - VMC
 - Hi Point Horse of Show. Eligible classes: 1.1-1.6, 1.11-1.14, 1.16-1.21, 1.23, 1.25, 2.5-2.13, 2.16-2.19, 2.21-2.22.
 - Hi Point Youth. Eligible Classes: F01, 3.1-3.18.
 - Whiteleys' Livestock Transport Hi Point Competitions
 - Branch Hi Point Horse – across all open classes (youth classes excluded) on day 1 for financial branch members. One horse rider combination to be nominated to the secretary.
 - Hi-Point Branch Youth Horse & Rider (across all youth classes on day 1) for financial branch youth members. One horse rider combination to be nominated to the secretary.
 - Hi Point Novice Horse. Eligible classes: 1.9, 1.26, 2.14, 2.21 for any Novice Horse competing.
 - Winners of ASHLAR Pulse Therapy's will be required to use their sessions when Abbey Webb is in their respective areas (special one off trips will not be made)
 - Heritage Stock Horse
 - Hi Point HSH Stock Horse – across all open classes on day 1. One horse rider combination to be nominated to the secretary.
14. Newcomer Ridden Class:
 - For registered ASH horses who have not competed under saddle in any equestrian discipline prior to 06.04.2025 (the start of the 2025 - 2026 Victorian ASH show season).
 - To be judged as a ridden hack class, looking for three good paces, moderate collection, manners & paces and overall appearance for future ridden class potential.
 - Each Victorian ASH branch to run a qualifying 'Newcomer' class at their branch show. A placing of 1st to 4th at a branch qualifier will enable the horse and rider that qualified the horse to compete in the final.
 - 1st place getters at any branch show cannot compete in this class at another branch again until the final.
 - The final is to run at the 2026 Victorian State Championships
- 15 SEAMC Horse of the year Competition.
 - The supreme led horse of the show is eligible to compete for the SEAMC Supreme Led Horse of the Year at the 2026 Vic State Championships
 - The Champion Hack 4 years and under and Champion Hack 5 years and over is eligible to compete for the SEAMC Hack Horse of the year at the 2026 Vic State Championships
 - The Champion working 4 years and under and Champion Working 5 years and over is eligible to compete for the SEAMC Hack Horse of the year at the 2026 Vic State Championships
- 16 Prize Money
 - Open Classes 1st \$10. Plus additional prize money as noted.

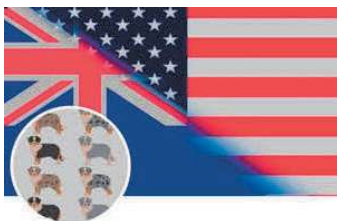
